## Purpose

The association centre of excellence awards committee is a working group focused on the development and advancement of CSAE's association centre of excellence awards initiatives.

## Accountability

- The association centre of excellence awards committee operates within the strategic direction of CSAE.
- The association centre of excellence awards committee reports to CSAE's volunteer relations specialist who is accountable to the President \& CEO.


## Authority

The association centre of excellence awards committee is involved in:

- Promoting the association centre of excellence awards program.
- Leveraging opportunities to recognize and celebrate successful programs, products or services that advance the association sector.
- Reviewing materials distributed to members regarding the call for applications for the association centre of excellence awards.
- Encouraging members to submit applications for the association centre of excellence awards.
- Receiving and evaluating applications for the association centre of excellence awards.
- Participating in the association centre of excellence awards celebration.


## Team Support

CSAE employees as designated, provide support to the association centre of excellence awards committee through full professional and administrative services.

## Committee Membership

- The association centre of excellence awards committee is comprised of a minimum eight to a maximum of ten members.
- Preference is given to CAE members or members in the process of acquiring the CAE designation.
- The association centre of excellence awards committee will represent members from across CSAE's networks and special interest groups.
- A committee member and CSAE's volunteer relations specialist, shall serve as co-chairs.
- Term: minimum one year, renewable once.

Committee Meetings

- Association centre of excellence awards committee meetings will be held every month, June through November, for a total of six meetings per calendar year.
- Additional meetings/work may be required during the year.
- The frequency of meetings may be reassessed by the committee and adjusted as needed.
